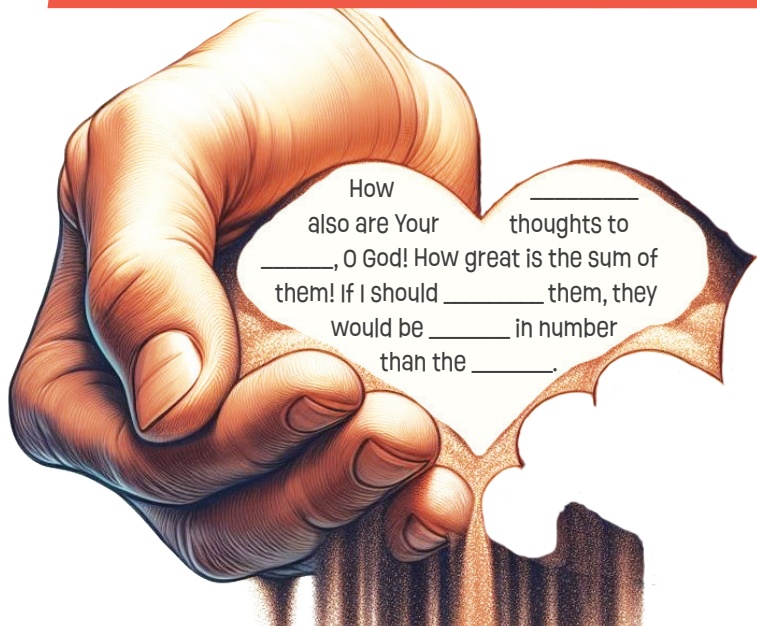

Fill in the blanks from Psalm 139:16-18 to see what God's thoughts toward you are more than. Then draw God's other hand holding the sand and color it.



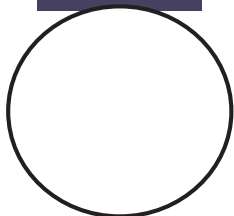
